- 2. ACO Reports for ACO attributed population care gaps reports.
- 3. **Population Risk Reports** for ACO attributed beneficiary risk reports.
- 4. CHP My Patient Care Gaps identifies opportunities for care delivery.
- 5. ACO Attributed Beneficiaries, the number of beneficiaries attributed to providers, groups or registries.
